<p>1. Purpose</p> <p>2. Authority SC -Art. XVII -A Sec. 17-1726-A</p> <p>Sec. 25-2509.3</p>	<p>Transportation for the students shall be provided in accordance with Charter School law and Board policy.</p> <p>The chartering district of the Capital Area School for the Arts (CASA) Charter School will provide regular transportation for the charter school students.</p> <p>1. Students who attend a charter school located in their school district of residence or a charter school located outside district boundaries at a distance not exceeding ten (10) miles by the nearest public highway, shall be provided free transportation to the charter school by their school district of residence .</p> <p>School districts of the first class shall also provide transportation to the students if they are the same age or are enrolled in the same grade, grades or their grade equivalents as any students of the district for whom transportation is provided under any program or policy to the schools of the district.</p> <p>Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, transportation shall be provided to charter school students by their school district of residence on such dates and periods that the charter school is in regular session, whether or not transportation is provided on such dates and periods to students attending schools of the district. Districts providing transportation to a charter school outside the district shall be eligible for subsidy payments under section 2509.3 for each public school student transported.</p> <p>2. In the event that the Secretary of Education determines that a school district is not providing the required transportation to students to the charter school, the Department of Education shall pay directly to the charter school funds for costs incurred in the transportation of its students. Payments to a charter school shall be determined in the following manner for each eligible student transported: the charter school shall receive a payment equal to the total expenditures for transportation of the school district divided by the total number of school students transported by the school district under any program or policy.</p> <p>3. The Department of Education shall deduct the amount paid to the charter school</p>

under subsection (2) from any and all payments made to the district.

4. A school district of the first class shall submit a copy of its current transportation policy to the Department of Education no later than August 1 of each year.

Students who attend the charter school located outside their school district of residence boundaries at a distance exceeding ten (10) miles by the nearest public highway shall be responsible for providing their own transportation to the charter school.
