As COVID-19 conditions continue to evolve, CASA will utilize guidance from the CDC to inform and drive our daily safety measures.

We continue to highly recommend vaccinations and appropriate hand hygiene to help mitigate the spread of COVID-19.

Masking will be optional for students, staff members, and visitors. Contact tracing will no longer take place unless multiple members of the school community test positive for COVID-19. In addition, students and staff members do not need to quarantine themselves if they come in contact with an infected person unless they are experiencing symptoms.

Students or faculty members who test positive are to isolate for five days regardless of their vaccination status. Isolation can cease when the individual is fever-free for 24 hours without the use of medications and their other symptoms are improving.

- Fever or chills
