SANITARY MANAGEMENT</p> <p>The Board recognizes that safeguarding the health and physical well-being of school students depends upon the cleanliness and proper sanitary conditions of the school buildings and grounds.</p> <p>The Board directs that a program of sanitary management shall be maintained in the building and explained periodically to staff members.</p> <p>The Board directs that standards be maintained to meet requirements set forth by the Pennsylvania Department of Health, Department of Labor & Industry, and any local agency that has jurisdiction.</p> <p>All facilities shall be inspected regularly for cleanliness and proper sanitation by the building principal and property manager.</p> <p>The Principal or designee shall develop and supervise a program for the cleanliness and sanitary management of the school, school grounds and school equipment pursuant to statute, State Board regulations and requirements of the local and state Boards of Health and the Department of Labor & Industry.</p> <p>There is an annual state health inspection of school buildings by the Sanitarian from the Office of the Secretary of Health, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.</p> <p>Teachers shall be responsible for the condition of their classrooms. Principals shall report to the Superintendent or designee any conditions that may threaten the comfort, health or safety of occupants.</p> <p>The Principal shall report to the Board any conditions that may threaten the comfort, health or safety of occupants.</p>
