224. CARE OF SCHOOL PROPERTY	
<p>1. Purpose</p>	<p>The Board believes that the charter school should help students learn to respect property and develop feelings of pride in community institutions.</p>
<p>2. Authority SC – Art. XVII - A</p> <p>SC 777 Pol. 218, 233</p> <p>SC 1338</p>	<p>The Board charges each student in the charter school with responsibility for the proper care of the school property, school supplies and equipment entrusted to the student's use.</p> <p>It is the policy of the Board that students who willfully cause damage to school property shall be subject to disciplinary measures. Students and others who damage or deface school property may be prosecuted and punished under law. Parents and guardians shall be held accountable for the actions of their child.</p> <p>The Board may report to appropriate juvenile authorities any student whose damage of school property is serious or chronic in nature. In no case shall referral to juvenile authorities be made without prior notification to the student's parent.</p>
<p>3. Delegation of Responsibility SC 109, 801</p>	<p>The Principal shall develop procedures to implement this policy which include rules for safekeeping and accounting of textbooks, supplies and equipment and an established schedule of costs for lost or damaged textbooks, supplies and equipment.</p> <p>Students are required to pay for all lost or damaged school textbooks, supplies and equipment.</p> <p>Vandalism reports shall include the number and kind of incident, cost to the charter school, and related information the Principal deems necessary.</p>
