Pre-Screening Portfolio

The Visual Art Program requires the submission of a pre-screening portfolio in order to be invited to a live group audition. Applicants who pass pre-screening will be contacted to schedule a live group audition at CASA Charter School on one of the audition dates.

Summary

Portfolio Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Photograph each artwork in even lighting using a smartphone. Please send 10-8 photos of artworks, three of which must be observational. Observational are done from real life people or objects, not photos. Example: Still life drawing, landscape drawing, portrait, etc.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Title the artworks as such: Your Name, Medium - Example: John Smith, pencil (or pen & ink, pastel, watercolor, acrylic, oil, digital work, etc.)
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Note: If the applicant does not pass the pre-screening portfolio, they are not guaranteed individualized feedback but are encouraged to re-apply for the following academic year.
Visual Art Live Group Audition (90 minutes)	<p>If students pass the pre-screening portfolio, they will be invited to a live group audition. Students will complete the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Applicant should bring a sketchbook to audition. No other materials will be required.• Participate in a one-hour drawing/painting class. The class will be structured as a combination of collaborative and independent studio work. We will be drawing a small still life and painting an apple.• Short written reflection & brief interview concerning the work created in the live group audition and pre-screening portfolio.
