	Title the artworks as such: Your Name, Medium - Example: John Smith, pencil
	(or pen & ink, pastel, watercolor, acrylic, oil, digital work, etc.)
	Note: If the applicant does not pass the pre-screening portfolio, they are not
	guaranteed individualized feedback but are encouraged to re-apply for the
	following academic year.
	If students pass the pre-screening portfolio, they will be invited to a live group audition. Students will complete the following:
Visual Art Live	Applicant should bring a sketchbook to audition. No other materials will be required.
<b>Group Audition</b>	Participate in a one-hour drawing/painting class. The class will be structured as a
( 90 minutes)	combination of collaborative and independent studio work. We will be drawing a small still life and painting a apple.
	Short written reflection & brief interview concerning the work created in the live group audition and pre-screening portfolio.
