In order to keep our school environment safe, we are requiring that all students and staff members complete a home COVID-19 screening in the evening and before leaving for school in the morning. Please use the Daily Home COVID-19 Screening Checklist below.

If a student or staff member is experiencing these symptoms, they are to **stay home** and notify Nurse Stillwater via email at astillwater@casa-arts.org or by calling 717-732-8450. Nurse Stillwater will communicate with families and staff members regarding symptoms and potential exposure. She will also provide information relating to attendance and re-entry to school procedures. Thank you!

Daily Home COVID-19 Screening Checklist

Students and staff members should stay home if they have any of these symptoms that cannot be attributed to another known cause:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

This list does not include all possible symptoms. People with COVID-19 have had a wide range of symptoms reported – ranging from mild symptoms to severe illness. Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus. People with these symptoms may have COVID-19 and should be tested. The COVID-19 test should be a PCR or antigen test from a medical provider such as a pharmacy or doctor's office. Unfortunately, although useful information in some situations, we cannot accept a home test result.
