Travel Restrictions:

On Monday, March 1, 2021, Governor Wolf announced that out-of-state travel restrictions have been eliminated. Wolf stated, "The current downward trend of cases nationwide and implementation of testing requirements and universal face covering on public transportation and transportation hubs are reducing the risk that interstate travel is a vector of disease transmission." CASA will also remove these restrictions from our Health and Safety Plan.

Vaccination and Exposure Information from the Pennsylvania Department of Health:

People who are vaccinated against COVID-19 do NOT need to quarantine after an exposure to another person with COVID-19 if they meet **ALL** of the following criteria:

- They are fully vaccinated (i.e., ≥ 2 weeks following receipt of the second dose in a 2-dose series, or ≥ 2 weeks following receipt of one dose of a single-dose vaccine);
- They are within 3 months following receipt of the last dose in the series; AND,
- They have remained asymptomatic since the current COVID-19 exposure.

Regardless of vaccination status, people who exhibit new or unexplained symptoms of possible COVID-19 still need to isolate and should consult their health care provider about being tested for COVID-19. Close contacts who have not received a vaccine or who do not meet all of the above criteria must follow existing quarantine guidance.
