Winter Keystone Examinations begin January 4, 2022. Keystone Exams are administered in the areas of English Literature, Algebra I, and Biology. The purpose of these tests is to provide a measure of performance for both our students and our school, and to fulfill Pennsylvania's responsibility under Chapter 4 Regulations and federal accountability requirements. Remediation classes will be recommended for non-proficient students if they have not already been taken.

Winter Keystone Exams will be administered to the following students:

Students in grades 9-11 who did not receive a score of proficient or advanced on previous Keystone Exams or students who have not yet taken a Keystone Exam.

Jan. 11 - Literature Module 2 – PM

Please make sure that your child is well rested, has eaten a healthy breakfast, and is on time to school during the testing window. **Make-up sessions will be held on January 12, 13, and 14 during the same time periods.
